

HOW TO EARN STATE PROBATION CREDITS



GUIDE TO NEW EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT INCENTIVES FOR PEOPLE ON PROBATION AND COMMUNITY CONTROL

Beginning July 1, 2022, people on state probation and community control under the Florida Department of Corrections are eligible to reduce their term of supervision by remaining compliant with ordered conditions and earning:

- Educational Credits
- Workforce Achievement Credits



Be rewarded for reaching your goals and improving your life and community.

EDUCATIONAL CREDITS

Subtract 60 days off your term of supervision for the completion of each new educational activity including:

- Graduate Equivalency Degree (GED)
- High School Diploma
- Academic Degree (Associate's, Bachelor's, etc)
- Vocational Certificate

WORKFORCE ACHIEVEMENT CREDITS

Subtract 30 days off your term of supervision for every 6 months of paid, continuous employment during which you worked at least 30 hours per week on average.

- Provide proof of employment to your officer (e.g. offer letter, pay stub, contract, etc.)
